## Supreme Court of Virginia Statistical Review 2018

**Introduction** In 2018, there were 1,704 petitions filed and 1,830 cases decided in the Supreme Court of Virginia (SCV). Although there has been a downward trend during the past 15 years, there were slight increases between 2008 and 2009 (<1.0%). Between 2014 and 2018, there was a decrease of 11.2% in petitions filed in the SCV, while there was an increase of 9.4% in cases decided. In 2018, there was a decrease of 4.4% in peitions filed and an increase of 2.6% in cases decided from the previous year. This caseload statistical review focuses on trends in filings and case types between 2014 and 2018 in the SCV.

**Cases Filed and Decided** The table above (Table 1) shows an overview of the case dispositions for the SCV for the past five calendar years, as well as the total petitions filed each of those years. In 2018, the SCV recorded 1,704 petitions filed, 78 less than the 1,782 in 2017 and 214 less than the 1,918 in 2014. There were 1,830 decided cases in 2018, an increase of 51 or 2.9% from the previous year. In 2018, 6.9% of cases that were decided were granted appeal petitions which increased 13.4% from 2017. In 2018, 10.7% of cases that were decided were original jurisdiction petitions. Table 2 shows the different SCV case types. The decrease recorded in petitions filed was driven by the decrease in criminal. In 2018, there was a decrease of 6.0% in criminal petitions. Civil petitions decreased by one or 0.2% from 538 in 2017 to 537 in 2018.

## **Case Filings Mix**

Criminal, civil and *writ of habeas corpus* cases constituted the majority or 87.1% of the petitions filed. The percentage of criminal petitions in 2014 was 42.2%, and this percentage rose in 2018 to 44.2% of total petitions filed. The percentage of civil petitions increased from 30.1% in 2014 to 31.5% in 2018. *Writ of habeas corpus* cases constituted 13.9% and 11.4% of the overall caseloads in 2014 and 2018, respectively.

**Appeal Petitions: Granted** Of the appeal petitions granted (127), civil petitions constituted the majority, 70.9% in 2018. In 2018, there was an increase in civil granted of 10 (12.5%) from 2017 and an increase of one (1.1%) from 2014. There were 28 granted criminal petitions, an increase of five or 21.7% from the 23 granted in 2017.

**Refused** In 2018, there were 1,195 cases refused with the majority (66.5%) being criminal in nature. There were decreases in civil and *habeas* appeals, yet there was an overall increase of 33 or 2.8% in the total refused appeal petitions from the previous year.

**Original Jurisdiction Petition** In 2018, the total number of original jurisdiction cases decided was 204, which is 20 cases or 10.9% more than 2017, and 21 cases or 9.3% less than 2014. Of the 204 cases, eight or 3.9% were awarded (eight *writ of habeas corpus*).

**Motions, Requests, and Filings** Table 5 shows filings by type. Notice of appeal constituted 20.2% of the total 1,972 filings in 2018. IFP Affidavit was 16.1% of the total and response or reply to a motion or objection was 6.7%. Motions and requests filed included appointment of counsel/ public defender and extension of time among various other categories. In 2018, there were 1,371 motions and requests filed in the SCV which was an increase of two or less than one percent from 2017.
